Greece was recognised as an independent state in 1828 and it is located in southeastern Europe at the southern tip of the Balkan peninsula. The country is bordered to the northwest by Albania, to the north by Northern Macedonia and Bulgaria, and to the northeast by Turkey. The Greek peninsula is surrounded by the eastern Mediterranean sea. On the east coast we have the Aegean Sea, on the west coast the Ionian Sea and on the south coast the Libyan Sea. Our population is about 10,691,204 people and our official language is Greek.

Xanthi

Is a city in the region of the Western Thrace, is located in Northeastern Greece. It is the capital of the regional unit of Xanthi. The city has a population of 56,151 people. The city is divided by the Kosynthos River, into the west part, where the old and the modern town are located, and the east part that boasts a rich natural environment.



Xanthi's landmarks







The "Old Town of Xanthi" is known throughout Greece for its distinctive architecture, combining many Byzantine Greek churches with neoclassical mansions of Greek merchants from the 18th and 19th centuries and Ottoman-Era mosques. There is also the "House of shadows" in the old town and the Greek Folk Art Museum.

Xanthi's festivals

Xanthi is famous throughout Greece for its annual spring carnival. Over 40 cultural associations from around Greece participate in the carnival program.





Every year in September we celebrate the festivities of the Old Town. The festivities include concerts, music and dance nights.





Our University





The Democritus University of Thrace was founded in 1973. It was named "Democritus" in honor of the ancient Greek philosopher Democritus who was born in Avdira, Xanthi.

The administrative seat of the University is located in the city of Komotini, while administrative services are provided in all four cities of Komotini, Alexandroupoli, Orestiada and Xanthi.

The DUTh geographically developed throughout Thrace, with 8 faculties, 18 Departments, and a number of Postgraduate Programs, with a student population of approximately 29,000. It is the only university institution in the Region of Eastern Macedonia - Thrace.

Faculty of Engineering



The Engineering Faculty of Xanthi housed partly in the city center but also with the continuous development of its buildings and infrastructure on the Campus of Kimmeria, northeast of Xanthi. The Engineering Faculty of Xanthi consists of five departments which are:

- → Civil Engineering
- → Electrical and Computer Engineering
- → Architectural Engineering
- → Environmental Engineering
- → Production and Management Engineering


BEST Xanthi
